1. Application of Mathematics in Engineering Field

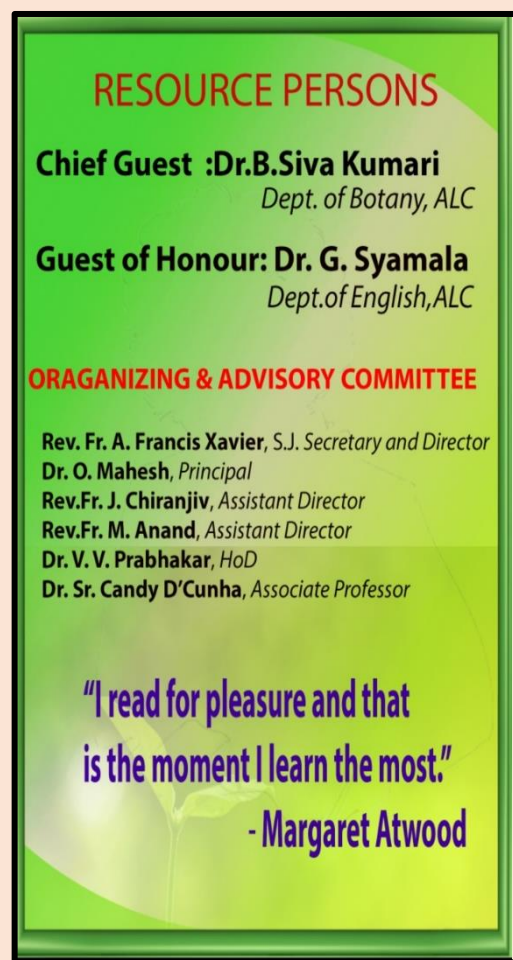
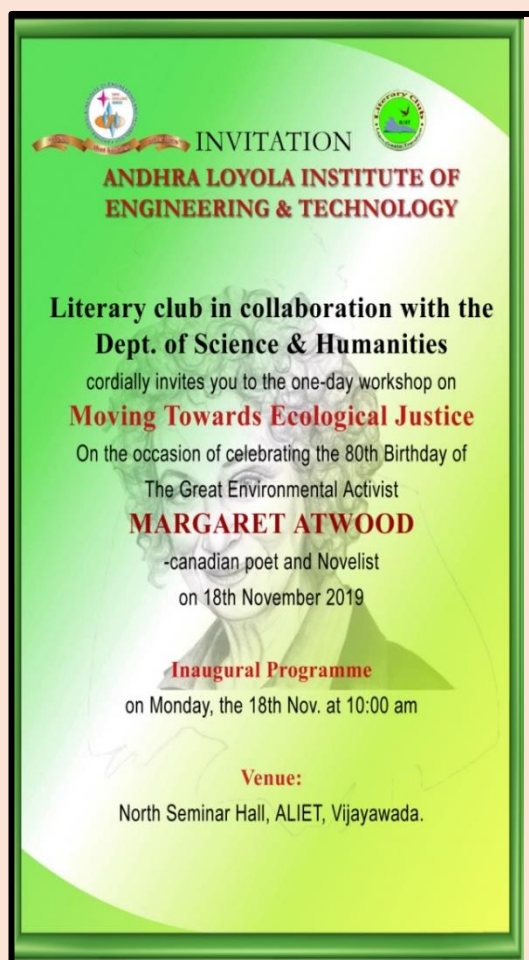

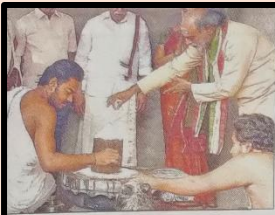


2. Moving towards Ecological Justice
