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## AWARNESS CAMP ON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

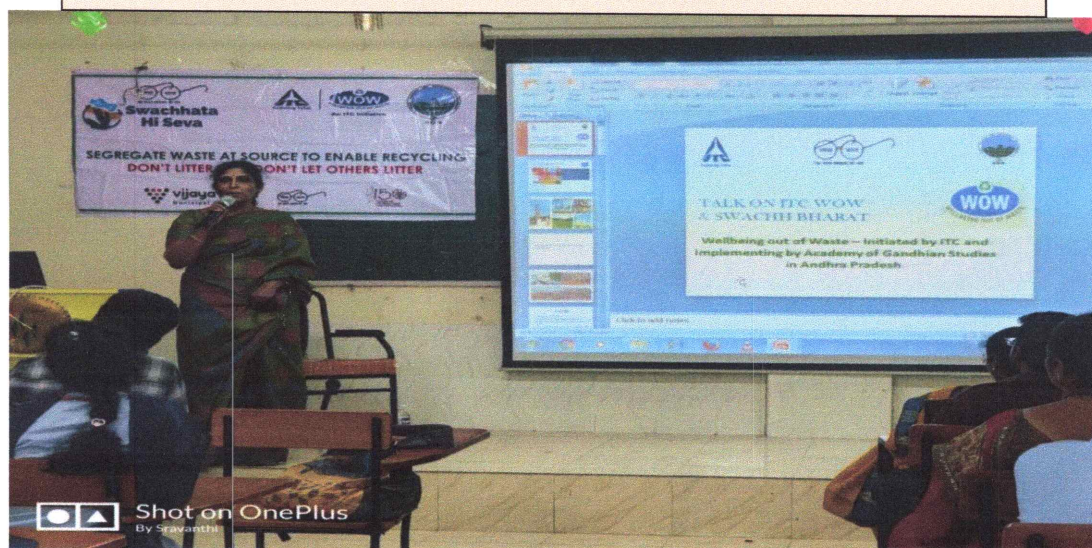
**Event: Wealth out of Waste (WOW Programme)**

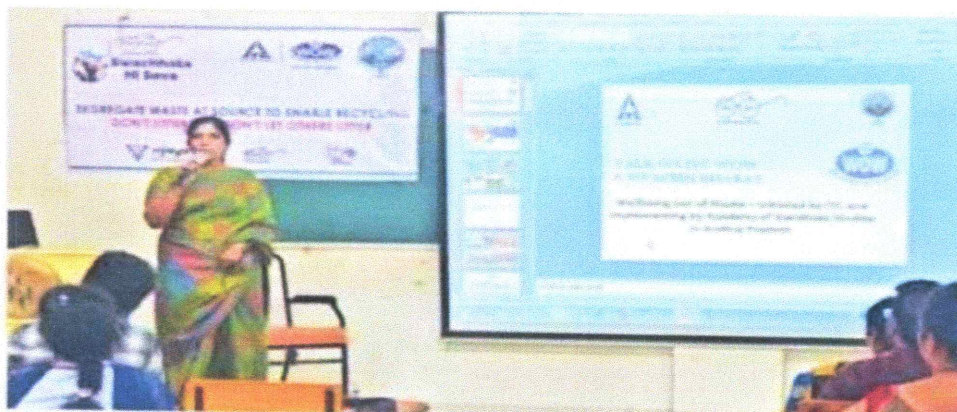
