



## Types of Exams

The entire process of examination is to provide learner the opportunity to solidify his/her intellectual capabilities. It also gives learner the academic credentials to ultimately assess the different levels of learning experiences and acquire knowledge for the holistic development of the learners' personality. Different types of exams are conducted as an integrated approach towards CIE pattern. Following are types of test with an underlined objective:

### Weekly tests

- ✚ Weekly tests are conducted for each subject in a course so as to make the students learn regularly and continuously exclusively by our college. (5)

### Laboratory evaluation

- ✚ For UG programs, 50 marks are for external evaluation and 25 marks are for internal evaluation. **For the purpose of CIE**, 25 marks are divided as follows: 10 marks are given for a day-to-day evaluation, 5 marks are for records and 10 marks are for internal laboratory test. In case of drawing subjects, 30 marks are for internal evaluation and 70 marks are for external evaluation. Out of 30 marks, 20 marks are for the day-to-day work and 10 marks are for internal test.

### Assignments

- ✚ Assignments are given for 5 marks. Students choose the topics of their choice from the text. They try to present the selected topic in an innovative manner. The main objective of this type of test is to increase the learning capability of students.



### Mid-term test

- ✚ Mid-term test is conducted for every subject. The entire syllabus consists of six units. The question paper is set from the first three units for the first mid-term test and from the remaining three units for the second mid-term test.

### Seminars

- ✚ Students are asked to give seminars on the topic of their choice. The main objective of seminar is to develop learners' speaking and discussion skills. This in fact helps learner to improve reading and listening comprehension and build confidence to communicate effectively.

### Online exam

- ✚ Online quiz is for 20 minutes. It is computerized test having objective types of questions such as fill in the blanks, MCQs, etc. The questions are textual based and has options to choose. The main objective of this test is to make learners read the original prescribed text.

### Descriptive examination

- ✚ The descriptive examination is assessed for 15 marks. The test is set for three questions for duration of an hour and a half. Students are required to answer all the three questions. The concerned staff member prepares the scheme of evaluation and based on that, all the answer scripts are evaluated

### Drawing Exam

- ✚ In case of drawing subjects, 30 marks are for internal evaluation and 70 marks are for external evaluation. Out of 30 marks, 20 marks are for the day-to-day work and 10 marks are for internal test.



## Rubrics

- Through Rubrics, various assessments like mini projects, major projects, laboratory experimentations, seminars, workshops and internship course record are considered for the attainment of Course Outcomes of all the courses apart from the set attainment levels.
