- 5. Tuples, Sets, Dictionaries, Packages, Modules and Regular Expressions.






3.The Department of IT has organized a 1-Day Online Webinar on "Career Industry 4.0" on 08th OCT 2020.

4.The Department of IT has organized a 2-Day Workshop on "DEEP LEARNING" in association with Indian Servers from 03rd to 04th August 2020.





He received honorary Doctorates from 48 universities and institutions from India and abroad. He spearheaded the Integrated Guided Missile Development Program and headed as DRDO Chief during 1992-1999. First scientist to hold the highest office as President of India inspiring millions. He inspired to think big in life. He penned nearly 25 books like India 2020, Vision for the new millennium, Mission of India: A Vision of Indian Youth. Kalam was awarded the coveted civilian awards - Padma Bhushan (1981), Padma Vibhushan (1990) and the highest civilian award in India-Bharat Ratna (1997).

Remembering Bharat Ratna Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam on his death anniversary ALIET conducted the plantation program, Rally and inaugurated 80mts length National Flag inside the Campus.


