### **Ragging and Eve teasing:**

Ragging and eve teasing are treated as a serious offense and are strictly prohibited on the campus. The college provides a conducive environment for the learners by keeping a close watch on the behavior of the students.

Anti-Ragging committee with the representatives of faculty members from all the departments has assigned responsibilities to create congenial atmosphere on the campus.

### **PURPOSE:**

- To create awareness among students regarding acts and punishments pertaining to ragging activities
- To build cordial relations among students for fulfilling organizations mission and objectives
- To generate awareness among students regarding how the confidence of the individual influences the national interest.

### **OBJECTIVES:**

- Anti-Ragging squads have to be constituted comprising of faculty members to make surprise visits to very sensitive location within the campus in the morning and in the break-time (11.50-12.45)
- For an offence committed in the department or a class room and elsewhere, the institution shall have the authority to reprimand fine or take any other suitable measure.
- Number of banners/posters giving detailed descriptions of Anti-Ragging activities such as Supreme court directives and penalty liable to be imposed on those involved in such activities, have to be displayed in the corridors and at various places within the campus

# Ragging

## Prohibition of ragging in educational institutions Act 26 of 1997

### Salient Features

- ⇒ Ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.
- ⇒ Ragging means doing an act which causes or is likely to cause Insult or Annoyance of Fear or Apprehension or Threat or Intimidation or outrage of modesty or Injury to a student

Assaulting or Using Criminal force or Criminal intimidation	 1 Year	+	<b>Rs. 2,000/-</b>
Wrongfully restraining or confining or causing hurt	 2 Years	+	<b>Rs. 5,000/-</b>
Causing grievous hurt, kidnapping or Abducts or rape or committing unnatural offence	 5 Years	+	<b>Rs. 10,000/-</b>
Causing death or abetting suicide	 10 Months	+	<b>Rs. 50,000/-</b>

# Ragging

## **ABSOLUTELY NO TO RAGGING**

---

1. Ragging is prohibited as per Act 26 of A.P. Legislative Assembly, 1997.
2. Ragging entails heavy fines and/or imprisonment.
3. Ragging invokes suspension and dismissal from the College.
4. Outsiders are prohibited from entering the College and Hostel without permission.
5. Girl students must be in their hostel rooms by 7.00 p.m.
6. All the students must carry their Identity Cards and show them when demanded
7. The Principal and the Wardens may visit the Hostels and inspect the rooms any time.
